Emergence from CCAA Restructuring Update

Trevor provided an update since Stelco formally emerged from creditor protection on June 30, 2017 under the new ownership of Bedrock Industries. The focus has turned to growing the company's business and establishing Stelco as a premier North American steel producer.

Performance under O.Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Hamilton Works coke battery operations under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates for the period June 1 – Sept. 23, 2017. Adrienne provided a verbal summary of the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change's comments regarding the audits it conducts on a regular basis.

Hamilton Works – Environmental Management System

Andy provided an overview of the facility's Environmental Management System (EMS) which has been evaluated by a third party auditor for recertification under the new ISO 14001 standard earlier this year. Andy highlighted key elements of the EMS and key enhancements in the new ISO 14001 standard. A general observation from a committee member is that the new ISO 14001 standard seems to be designed to support and empower employees at all levels within an organization to assess environmental improvement opportunities.
