## Review and Approval of Minutes of 19 June 2018

## Performance under O.Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Andy provided a summary of the performance of the Lake Erie Works coke battery operations under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates from Jan 2018 – Oct 2018. Review of community complaints (0) regarding our coke battery operation. Adrienne Clark provided a verbal summary of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks comments regarding the coke battery operations.

## Coke Oven Battery Rehabilitation

Andy provided a brief update on Lake Erie Works' Coke Battery refurbishment project. Andy gave an overview of the anatomy of the battery and highlights of key planned repairs scheduled to commence in 2019.

## Community Concerns

Concern was brought up regarding dust fall on neighbouring properties. Andy and Sean highlighted some of the methods used to manage fugitive dust, in accordance with best management practices. Another CLC member noted their satisfaction with Stelco's efforts to mitigate air emissions during the recent CLC plant tour. A discolored bird bath water was mentioned by one CLC member, with the MECP suggesting that algal growth is a more probable cause.
