Welcome and Safety Contact

Review and Approval of Agenda

Review and Approval of Minutes of 17 October 2018

Minutes from the 17 October 2018 meeting were reviewed and accepted as presented.

Performance under O. Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Lake Erie Works coke battery operations under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates from Q4 2018. Supplementary information on 2019 YTD was also provided. Review of community complaints (0) regarding our coke battery operation. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks had no additional comments regarding the coke battery operations.

Coke Oven Battery Upgrades

Pete provided an update on Lake Erie Works' Coke Battery repair and upgrade project. Specific details were given on the cokemaking process, installation of water sealed standpipe caps and the various equipment and process upgrades.

Winter Dust Management

Barry provided an overview of dust management practices at the raw material storage areas including pile inspection frequencies, semi-permanent winter sealing and high wind condition operating practices. Specific details were provided on Stelco's automated sprinkler system used for dust suppression.

Community Concerns

The group discussed the performance of the coke battery in relation to the Site-Specific Standard requirements in the year 2020. The coke battery repair and upgrade project will provide environmental benefits in relation to the Site-Specific Standard. In addition, the group discussed air monitoring and modelling in relation to environmental compliance.
