Welcome and Safety Contact

Review and Approval of Agenda

Review and Approval of Minutes of 21 March 2019

Performance under O. Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Sean provided a summary of the performance of the Lake Erie Works coke battery operations under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates from March 1 to May 31. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks had no additional comments regarding the coke battery operations.

Coke Oven Battery Rehabilitation

Pete provided an update on Lake Erie Works' Coke Battery repair and upgrade project. Specific details were given on the coke side emission control system, replacement brick delivery status and oven wall conditions.

Barry provided an overview of dust management practices at the coal fields including semi-permanent sealing, the use of technology to predict wind patterns and recent upgrades to the automated sprinkler system.

Emission Control at Lake Erie Works – Baghouses

Garret explained the various type of baghouses in operation at Lake Erie works, including specific examples at our Ironmaking and Steelmaking divisions. Sample bags were brought in to help further illustrate the air cleaning system operating on site.

Community Concerns

Trevor provided an update to the group regarding Lake Erie Work's new cogeneration development agreement with DTE. The group discussed the upcoming transition to a possible technical standard at the end of term for the Site-Specific Standard. Concern was raised regarding noise pollution from back-up beepers, particularly during the winter.
