Review and Approval of Agenda

Review and Approval of Minutes of 12 June 2019

Performance under O.Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Hamilton Works coke battery operations between June 1 – Aug 31 under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks had no additional comments. Katie also provided a summary of community complaints received by Stelco for this time period.

Dust Management Program

Carter and Andy provided an overview of the fugitive dust management program at Hamilton Works. In addition, Carter provided information on a new pilot sprinkler system at the coalfield.

Community Concerns

Jochen shared comments related to the most recent public quarterly teleconference from Stelco's executive management to investors, with a key message of maximizing returns to

shareholders. Comments were received regarding the environmental release obtained by the company as part of emergence from CCAA in 2017.

Jochen described the Ministry of Environment's Technical Standards development process for the integrated steel sector which is currently underway. While community stakeholders are members of the larger Working Group, he expressed the desire for community stakeholders to participate in the various technical subcommittees of this process. Lynda shares Jochen's comments.

Lynda also suggested that the Stelco Development group provide an opportunity to listen to community stakeholders feedback on development plans at the Hamilton site.
