Performance under O. Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Lake Erie Works coke battery operations under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates from March 1 to May 31. Katie touched on the operational difficulties of running only half of the battery during the end flue rehabilitation as it relates to Site-Specific Standard Order compliance. Review of community complaints (0) regarding our coke battery operation. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks had no additional comments regarding the coke battery operations.

Coke Oven Battery Rehabilitation

Pete provided an update on Lake Erie Works' Coke Battery repair and upgrade project. Specific details were given on the ironwork upgrades, battery anatomy and flue brick repairs.
