Performance under O. Reg. 419/05 Site Specific Standard Order - Particulates

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Lake Erie Works coke battery operations under the Site-Specific Standard Order for particulates from January 1 to March 31. Katie spoke about some of the operational challenges of running only half of the battery during the end flue rehabilitation as it relates to Site-Specific Standard compliance. Review of community complaints (0) regarding our coke battery operation. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) mentioned that the Ministry and the steel industry are working on developing an updated version of Method 303 (regular battery environmental emissions audit) for Ontario.
