# **Review and Approval of Agenda**

The committee accepted them as presented. The committee also accepted the draft meeting notes of the previous meeting.

## **Coke Battery Performance**

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Hamilton Works coke battery operations for Q3 2021 in relation to the regular Method 303 and Method 9 audits conducted on-site.

Jeremy G of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) indicated that he was in the facility a few times in Q3 and confirmed that MECP's Method 303 and Method 9 audits align with Stelco's audit results.

### **Water Monitoring Overview**

Andy and Julie provided an overview of effluent monitoring at Hamilton Works. This included a summary of the facility's water outfalls as well as the water quality in comparison to the Hamilton Harbour Remedial Action Plan targets for water quality. Julie noted that steel mills are the only source where there are negative loadings to the harbour. This is positive news.

# **Community Comments**

Lynda asked about the status of the demolition of the basic oxygen furnace. Trevor highlighted that the work is being conducted responsibly, including using third party consultants to evaluate work plans prior to implementation. The scrap steel that is removed from the facility is recycled back into our own operations.
