Review and Approval of Agenda

The committee accepted them as presented. The committee also accepted the draft meeting notes of the previous meeting.

Coke Battery Performance

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Hamilton Works coke battery operations for Q3 2022 based on the Method 303 environmental audits conducted on a regular basis. This includes a brief period of a little over one week when the battery was hot idled as part of contingency planning related to labour contract negotiations. Coke battery audit results demonstrated compliance with all 2022 limits (30-day rolling averages).

One of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) representatives noted that the most recent audit conducted at the Hamilton Works battery was conducted about two weeks ago. Their results were in line with those of Stelco's auditor. In general, things seem to be working well at this coke battery.

Community Comments

Kerry enquired about the demolition of the blast furnace on the Hamilton Works lands, including timing of advance notification. Trevor indicated that Stelco was taking direction from Slate Asset Management, who owned the asset.
