Welcome

Review and Approval of Agenda

The committee accepted them as presented. The committee also accepted the draft meeting notes of the previous meeting.

Coke Battery Performance

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Hamilton Works coke battery operations for Q4 2022 based on the Method 303 environmental audits conducted on a regular basis. Coke battery audit results demonstrated compliance with all 2022 limits.

One of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) representatives noted that the Stelco audit results reported are in line with the Ministry representative's observations from battery inspections as recently as the previous week. Another audit may be conducted later this fiscal year (likely later in February).

Community Comments

Jochen asked for clarification on how pushing emission opacities in the Method 303 daily audits are quantified. Stelco representatives explained the methodology on how the pushing emission opacity is calculated, and described the operational adjustment process, if such an adjustment is required in accordance with Method 303.

Jochen enquired about whether future CLC meetings may take place in-person. Stelco indicated at this point in time, we plan to keep the meetings in the existing virtual format. We can review again in the future, if necessary.
