Coke Battery Performance – Q3 2024

Katie provided a summary of the results of the daily and 30-day rolling average results for the Method 303 environmental audits. The coke battery continues to be in compliance with the 30-day rolling average limits.

Jeremy Gamble indicated that Tyler Kelly is on vacation this week and asked Stelco to confirm that some of the pushing emissions observations are zero percent. Stelco confirmed it. No other updates from the Ministry.

Additional Updates

Stelco provided a summary of additional feedback received from neighbours in Q3 2024 and steps taken to resolve concerns that were raised.

Katie shared that a notice of consultation was published in the local newspaper on October 3 for in-person and virtual consultation events that Stelco is hosting for the LEW Quarry Landfill Expansion Project in late October.

Lastly, at the next CLC meeting on Jan 15, 2025, members will review the proposed CLC meeting dates for the remainder of 2025.

Community Feedback

Stu provided feedback regarding some dust recently observed. Stelco noted his comments for further internal review. This also includes some feedback received from some other neighbours.

Stu also asked about two monitoring wells south of LEW. Petar confirmed that the two boreholes are no longer being used and will be decommissioned.
